
This consultation presentation has been prepared by Ingleton Wood LLP (IW) who are working on behalf of Morgan Sindall to deliver a new school expansion project on the Essex County Council Framework.

Why is an expansion at Castledon School needed?

There is increased need for provision for children and young people with moderate learning difficulties in South Essex and the need to replace temporary classrooms, which have reached the end of their life cycle, will place considerable pressure on Castledon School if not addressed. Demand for places at the school has grown over the years, due to population growth and a rise in the number of children and young people who require a special school place, putting pressure on the school's infrastructure. Pupil numbers at the school have been increasing steadily and at the same time the school has accommodated a wider range of special educational need; whilst classroom capacity has expanded the specialist spaces required to meet both increased numbers and a wider range of needs is not sufficient and needs to be addressed. The school is dependent on the temporary classrooms to accommodate existing pupils and without the new facilities ECC will no longer be able to meet current needs and have no capacity within the existing building for the forecast increased pupil population.

What is proposed to facilitate the expansion?

New Two Storey Building

The building will provide a new fit for purpose teaching facility that will contain a range of specialist and general teaching provision, extending the school's offer to provide a broad curriculum that is tailored for their requirements and pupil needs. The new building will be constructed to achieve net zero in operation and an Energy Use Intensity of 61 kWh/m2yr using an all-electric solution.

Oriel Building Extension

The extension to the orial building will provide one additional classroom, group room, store room, WCs & associated circulation

External Facilities

Appropriate provisions of outdoor net areas have been considered as part of the proposal. A new astro turf pitch is proposed to the playing fields to improve the sports offer on site.







Proposed New Block






Proposed First Floor Plan

The building will provide a new fit for purpose teaching facility that will contain a range of specialist and general teaching provision, extending the school's offer to provide a broad curriculum that is tailored for their requirements and pupil needs. The new building will be constructed to achieve net zero in operation and an Energy Use Intensity of 61 kWh/m2yr using an all-electric solution.

The L-shaped massing of the building has been designed to consider the impact on the key site constraints as well as suit the requirements of the internal spaces. A twostorey proposal is considered appropriate to minimise the building footprint and harm of the Green Belt.

The proposed material palette of cladding and brickwork and has been chosen to provide a fresh and contemporary aesthetic whilst providing a solution that is robust and requires low maintenance. Using buff facing brickwork will be sympathetic to its wider residential setting and help to soften the building's visual appearance.

Material palette: facing brickwork, light grey and blue vertical cladding.


Proposed Extension to Oriel Building



An extension is proposed to the existing Oriel building which is to provide one additional classroom, group room, store room, WCs & associated circulation.

The design will be in keeping with the existing architecture, mimicking the fenestration designs and red brick material palette.

New windows are proposed on the North and South elevations of the classroom adjacent to compensate for the loss of natural daylight and ventilation lost to the extension.

CASTLEDON SCHOOL EXPANSION Summary and Time-frames

Where we are in the planning process

The proposals to support the school's expansion have been issued to the following statutoryconsultees and determining bodies:

- ECC Highways
- Sport England
- Ecology Officer
- Arboricultural Officer
- Urban Design Officer

Since the preapplication submission, Ingleton Wood in conjunction with Castledon School have been liaising with our own consultant team of Acousticians, Ecologists, Arboriculturists, Engineers, Architects and Landscape Consultants. These discussions have shaped the proposals that form part of this public consultation to ensure that they meet a number of specialist requirements in terms of design, scale and location of the new built form proposed.

The existing number of pupils at the school is currently 171 (these numbers exclude the sixth form who are acommodated in a seperate building) whilst the existing Castledon facilities are designed to acommodate 114 pupils. The proposed new build and internal adaptations to the site will provide space for a total of 196 pupils, increasing the capacity of buildings on site by 82 pupils.
