

DUNTON FIELDS NURSERY SCHOOL

The new nursery is designed to be fully accessible throughout. Approaches will be gently sloped and level thresholds will facilitate easy access. Accessible and assisted facilities will be provided internally for staff and children.

The following pupil numbers will be accommodated:

- 0-2 year olds – 12
- 2-3 year olds – 20
- 3-4 year olds – 24

There will be three classrooms, one for each age group, a staff room, office, reception, boys and girls toilets and washrooms, kitchen and laundry.

The proposed building will be compact, suitably scaled and designed in relation to the site and the scale of the surrounding residential development.

The proposed external palette of materials comprises white render, vertical 'Thermowood' cladding and a red brick plinth.

The roof will have a shallow fall to allow for water run-off, and roof lights that provide natural light to the circulation area and classrooms.

At the school entrance, it has been proposed to provide a sheltered buggy area.
