### INTRODUCTION

Thank you for taking the time to visit our public exhibition today. These boards will provide you with an overview of the proposed development which includes a new teaching block, kitchen extension and all-weather games area.

Freshwaters Primary Academy currently operates as a 2-form entry (420 pupil) facility but does not have the necessary teaching and support spaces for its pupils. These proposals seek to address this issue by providing additional space in the new teaching block. It is not proposed to increase the number of pupils or staff at the school.

The new all-weather games area will provide another facility for sports and outdoor activities to the south of the existing playing field.

## PROPOSED LAYOUT FOR NEW **TEACHING BLOCK**

### **Project Description:**

To provide additional accommodation to support the existing 14 classrooms and enable the school to operate effectively at the existing 2 form-entry (420 pupil places).

### Summary of the Proposed Works:

New-build teaching block (shown right) to provide a new Studio Hall for teaching, dance and sports, Library and Food Tech room, with associated WCs, storage and Plant room.

Existing school Kitchen enlarged to increase capacity at lunch times.

Remodelling of the existing Staff room to accommodate the extra teachers and teaching assistants now working at the school.

Remodelling to create one new Group room.

Proposed all-weather Multi-Use Games Area to the south-eastern corner of the site, south of the existing playing field which will be unaffected.




