

SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT: MOUNTNESSING C of E PRIMARY SCHOOL

The expansion works have been designed as an extension to the main ingress point of the existing upper school building, therefore maintaining a natural building approach and circulation flow through the new building into the existing accommodation.

The siting of the new extension provides an opportunity to reanimate the existing upper school site whilst minimising encroachment onto the root protection zones and ecology within the existing habitat area. The location is mindful not to impact on any existing field provision and site shortfalls as its sited within the footprint of the existing relocatable classroom and existing non-net float area.

The new extension will accommodate; 3no junior classrooms, a multi-use practical room, a library, SEN room, staff room, and other associated administration and ancillary spaces.

As part of the scheme, the formal hard play area will be extended to provide a new full-sized netball court.
