Invitation to attend a Public Exhibition relating to the proposed new primary school associated with the Gilden Way housing development.

Essex County Council, as the Education Authority, proposes to build a new 2 form entry (420 pupils) primary school. This project will provide brand new accommodation and facilities for pupils attending the school and provide a stimulating educational environment for all users. The project design team has been developing a proposal that would meet the school's educational need and fits well on the school site.

We would like to invite you to an exhibition to see the outline proposals and to have your say before the proposals are completed for submission to the County Planning Authority as a full planning application. There will be comment forms at the exhibition that we would ask are completed so that we can capture and consider the views prior to the submission of the planning application.

Representatives from the County Council and the appointed Design and Build team will be on hand to discuss the proposals. It is an opportunity for all with an interest in the proposals to view the plans, ask questions and offer their opinion.

The exhibition will be held at: **Harlowbury Primary School, Watlington Road, Harlow on Wednesday 16th October 2019, From 2.30pm to 7.30pm**
