



Domestic Abuse Champion (SETDAB Network)

Role Purpose

To act as a champion on domestic abuse within their organisation and contribute to a multi-agency network to drive organisational and system-wide improvement in domestic abuse awareness, response, and partnership working.

Key Duties

- **Raising awareness and promoting good practice** around domestic abuse across their organisation/community.
- **Sharing information and learning from SETDAB**, including cascading updates, resources, communications and training.
- **Promote pathways into DA Services** across organisation.
- **Ensure learning from DARRDs** is cascaded and embedded throughout their organisation.
- **Supporting organisational development**, including DA policies, procedures, and training.
- **Building networks and partnerships** internally and externally to improve collaboration and service pathways.
- **Participating in training, meetings, and CPD**, including contributing to champion forums.
- **Maintaining up-to-date knowledge of domestic abuse, safeguarding, and relevant legislation.**
- **Highlighting development areas** that network could support.
- **Share lived experience insights** championing survivors and holding perpetrators accountable.

Skills and experience

- Understanding of domestic abuse dynamics.
- Participating in internal and external ongoing learning and development opportunities e.g. SETDAB suite of eLearning courses.

- Within own organisation.
- Link to SETDAB network (no direct line management).
